Just like fresh citrus fruits have different parts, so do sentences. Most sentences have a subject (*noun*) and an action (*verb*). *Adjectives* are words that are used to describe nouns. Nouns, verbs and adjectives are all called *parts of speech*.

A **noun** is a person, place or thing.

Florida, farmer and tree are all nouns.



A **verb** is a word that shows action or being.

Grow, peel and eat are all verbs.



An **adjective** is a word that describes a noun.

Sweet, round and delicious are all adjectives.
